

General Information

Information center at Rey Cup

The Information center at ReyCup is based at Próttur Clubhouse. At the information center you can receive any information regarding the tournament schedule, swimming pools, restaurants or any general information

*If a player has lost the tournament bracelet, it is important that the player and a team chaperone come to the information center to receive a new bracelet.

Tournament bracelets

It is extremely important that players do not lose their bracelets throughout the tournament. The tournament bracelets are the access to all tournament events, accommodation, lunch and dinner, etc. Each team gets two extra bracelets for team chaperones or coaches that accompany the team to events and to Hilton.

If the tournament bracelet is lost/torn, please go to the information center for a new bracelet.

Accommodation for coaches

Coaches are welcome to the club house for fresh beverages, food and snacks throughout the tournament. It will be open from 08:00-19:00

Medical Center

Medical center will be open from 08:00-19:00 throughout the tournament. It is accessible for all players and it is located at Próttur clubhouse.

Accommodation

**If a classroom is left dirty, trashy and in a bad condition, ReyCup will claim a cleaning fee of 20.000 ISL kr.*

A team chaperone will need to stay with the team at the accommodation at all times.

Breakfast

Breakfast is served at each accommodation. Breakfast is served from 07:00-09:00.

Lunch and Dinner at Hilton Hotel

Lunch and dinner is served at Hilton on Thursday and Friday. Dinner on Saturday is served at the BBQ event in the family park.

Changing rooms

We recommend that teams use the facilities at the swimming pool as they have free access throughout the tournament. Please contact the information center for any special requests.

Dance at Hilton Hotel

Rey Cup Dance will be held on Friday 28th of July. Dance begins at 20:30 and is finished at 22:30. Local artists and DJs will play at the dance. Teams need to be accompanied by a chaperone.

BBQ Event

Family tickets can be bought at the clubhouse prior to the event.

Event starts at 18:45 with a local DJ and burgers will be served until 21:30.

Live Final Rally

Finals are played at the national stadium on Sunday from 12:00-16:00 followed with the award ceremony straight after. This event is live on national television.

Swimming Pool

The Swimming pool is free of access for all participants during the tournament days. Swimming pool is open from 6:30 am to 22:00 pm and on weekends 8:00am to 22:00pm.

Family theme park

All Rey Cup participants get free access throughout the tournament. Opening hours are from 10:00-18:00.

Lost and Found

Lost and found can be found at the Þróttur clubhouse.

Other information

Tournament Rules

REYCUP is played in accordance with the rules of FIFA and where applicable by the rules of the Icelandic Football Association.

2. Type of Tournament

The teams will be grouped in a pool of three to six teams. All teams in a group play each other. The final pool standing will be the result of the amount of points each team has achieved:

Win 3 points

Draw 1 point

Loss 0 point

If two or more teams have the same number of points, the final standing will be decided by:

Goal difference

Highest number of goals scored

Individual result between the teams in question

If still undecided, the winner will be drawn by the Tournament Committee

The match program is preliminary. Each coach must check with the REYCUP Center if any changes have occurred.

If after regular playing time in knock out stage the result is still inconclusive, the game will be decided by a penalty shootout according to the FIFA rules (3 penalties per team, then one until final result).

3. Classifications

REYCUP follows the international practice of classification, which rules that each age group makes a team.

REY CUP does however make an exception permitting teams to follow the Icelandic classification, i.e. 13 and 14 year olds can play together and 15 and 16 together. The Tournament Committee deals individually with applications of teams which do not follow the KSI rules. A maximum of 3 older players from the previous year can play in any match. A team that has been accepted by the Tournament Committee is considered qualified to play in the tournament.

4. Match Period

2 x 25 minutes unless otherwise decided and announced in advance. Half time is 5 minutes.

5. Number of Players

Each team has the opportunity to use an unlimited number of players, allowing a player to re-enter the game after being substituted. Substitution takes place at the midfield line after the referee has been notified. Only players who have been registered prior to the tournament start can play.

6. Games

Before the tournament the Tournament Committee can ask for a name list of all players in the registered teams.

2. Shin guards are requested.

3. Screw studs are not allowed.

7. Walk-Over

A team that does not show up for a game will receive a 3:0 defeat. A team that will not show up for two games will, unless the Tournament Committee decides otherwise, be suspended from the tournament and their results will be canceled from the scoreboard.

8. Playing Fields

All matches are played on grass fields or artificial fields.

9. Referees

The Tournament Committee selects the referees. Two referees are refereeing each game. In the finals there are three referees.

10. Tournament Committee

REY CUP Board of Directors appoints the Tournament Committee.

11. Tournament Jury.

The Tournament Committee appoints the tournament jury. The jury deals with written complaints regarding tournament games.

12. Protests and complaints

Written protests shall be submitted to the tournament jury in the REY CUP Center within an hour after the end of game in question. The decision of the jury is final. Suspended players will not be allowed to participate in the next game following suspension. Two yellow cards or a red card lead to an automatic one match suspension.

13. Prizes

Winners receive the REY CUP trophy and each player in the finals receives a medal.

Emphasis is on fair play and a positive attitude of participants during the tournament.

Rey Cup – International Football & Fun

Important to keep the tournament bracelet on the wrist at all times during the tournament. It is the access to all events, fields and accommodation.

Rules at accommodation

Accommodation needs to be cleaned and ready for handover at 14:00 on Sunday.

- Team chaperone needs to accompany the team at all times at the accommodation.
- Respect other teams and remain quiet in the common area.
- Lights out and quiet at 23:00 pm.
- Clean up after yourself and make sure to put all trash in trash cans.
- Do not wear football boots indoors.
- All smoking and drinking is strictly forbidden at the accommodation.
- Footballs are not allowed indoors.
- Make sure to clean the rooms properly before Sunday.
- Make sure to lock doors when leaving the rooms.
- Personal responsibility on all personal items.
